

LARGE SCALE BRIGGS BOILER FOR SALE

Hi, just passing on this information that may be of use to someone in the model traction engine fraternity.

This boiler was intended to become part of a large scale Clayton and Shuttleworth TE. It has been professionally constructed and welded and is complete but un-tubed and is registered as a boiler under construction through the AMBSC.

Now here comes the difficult part. It was discovered that the volume of the boiler exceeded the 50 litre limit set by the AMBSC and further progress on the boiler was therefore suspended.

Unfortunately before the issue could be resolved the boiler became part of a deceased estate and now is in the hands of a person that is anxious to see the boiler put to good use and is only asking a nominal sum for its purchase. I have seen the boiler and can vouch for the quality of construction; it would certainly be a shame if it ended up as scrap metal.

If someone was to think of taking it on there is at least 2 possible ways forward. One would be to have the front tube plate moved back sufficiently to bring the volume below the 50L limit and proceed with testing under AMBSC. Another would be to investigate if the existing documentation is acceptable to some other examining authority and proceed with the boiler outside the AMBSC.

The boiler comes with a set of drawings for the Clayton and Shuttleworth TE and also one of the drive shafts, possibly the back axle.
